

Digital Competitions

N4C is adding digital competitions this year. Consequently, we plan to hold digital competitions, as well. In order for the winners of our competitions to be admissible in the N4C competitions, they must meet certain criteria. The following draft of rules for the LCC digital competitions follow. There will be a forum during the judging of the summer 4x6 competition August 22, in which we will discuss these rules and how to handle digital entries. It will be important to attend if you plan to compete in this interesting new medium.

Note: This is a trial program for N4C, so they will not be awarding points for winners in the Digital Media category.

LCC Digital Photo Competition Rules

(Eligible for N4C competition—not eligible for points at this time)

1. All photos to be of the “Pictorial Photography” category of N4C (all photo subjects qualify; “interest” accounts for 1/3 of the score).
2. Photos may be with digital camera, or scanned from film.
3. Photographs must be taken by the entrant.
4. Entrants give N4C the right to reproduce their images in any way.
5. Images must be in .jpg format.
6. Maximum image size is 1024 pixels wide by 768 pixels high. Max. file size is 500 kb.
7. Naming your image files is critical: example 01,LR028,DP,Beautiful Sunset.jpg (no spaces) where:

01 = to be used by Competition Committee

LR028 = entrant’s personal N4C member number (to be assigned by the Competitions Committee) (LR indicates Lincoln Camera Club)

DP = contest category (they will all be “DP” for time being)

Beautiful Sunset = image title

Note: .jpg is the file extension; commas are required as indicated.

8. Images may be sent by e-mail to Darlene Duvall dd81503@alltel.net by the general meeting date, or brought to the general meeting on CD.
9. Maximum of 3 entries per person.
10. Images may be manipulated as desired.
11. Judging will be at a special “Competition” night soon after the general meeting.
